WHERE: Mildura Racing Club, 53 Racecourse Road, (off Cowra Ave) Nichols Point.

CAR PARKING: The main carpark is located in the centre of the racing track, with disabled parking at the main gate. Follow the signs and the directions of our helpful parking attendants.
