

A message from Member for Mildura Ali Cupper

THE Mildura Field Days are back and it's a great time to come together.

The last 12 months have seen mixed fortunes for different crops, but the rainfall has been welcomed by most, especially our dryland farmers.

Generally speaking, it's an exciting time to be on the land.

Agricultural production in Australia is now valued at around 81 billion dollars.

We've seen some bumper winter crops due to recent weather patterns, with the wheat, barley, sorghum, canola and some fruit and nut industries reaching record high levels of production.

The recent rainfall across the Mallee and Wimmera definitely provides some bright prospects for the year ahead. But it's not all sunshine and roses.

For instance, the gross value of wine grape production has fallen despite a record national harvest.

Some have forecast a few challenging years ahead, with an anticipated drop off in export value across many industries, and the continued disruption of global demand and supply chains.

ABARES expects there will be drop offs in value in the coming year for wheat, barley and sorghum, oilseeds (canola), wine and wine grapes.

The lack of price security around input costs is also causing concern.

The availability of urea supplies and some chemical sprays will no doubt be a factor moving With this in mind, preparedness is key.

The Mildura Field Days will exhibit some of the latest developments in the world of farming.



Community and growers take up tools for *fruit fly management*

FINDING simple, sustainable and cost-effective ways to manage fruit fly on commercial properties and in home gardens is the mission of the Greater Sunraysia Pest Free Area Committee – and the organisation says the community is responding.

"Our aim has always been to give people the knowledge they need to be able to manage this pest themselves and as Queensland Fruit Fly (Qfly) has become established in our region, that's become more important than ever," said GSPFA Regional Coordinator Narelle Beattie.

"We're the resource that links growers, whether they're commercial producers or backyard gardeners, to the information and support they're looking for, as well as a bit of one-on-one coaching if they need it," she said.

Ms Beattie and the GSPFA's friendly staff Trish Witney and Clarissa Davis will be at the 2022 Mildura Field Days, and available for information, advice or bookings for free tree removals for domestic gardens.

Ms Beattie said for commercial growers, the mere presence of Qfly in their local areas was costing them money in additional post-harvest requirements to maintain markets.

"I think both commercial growers and home gardeners are now accepting the fact that Qfly is

here to stay – it's not just a case of treading water and it will go away, but they have to actively manage it," Ms Beattie said.

"The understanding is building up among growers that because fruit fly is established here now, control strategies need to be applied early and continuously after fruit set because once eggs are laid in fruit, it's too late," she said.

"Growers are now getting organised, planning their fruit fly control as part of their overall property pest management, and they're monitoring early – but we're always happy for our GSPFA field officers to come and help with getting a plan in place, because it's not just a case of one-size-fits-all."

GSPFA community support officer Trish Witney said from a dollars and sense point of view it's often cheaper to go and buy fruit and vegetables from a retailer, but community members were returning to the satisfaction of home gardening.

"Fruit fly has taken the fun out of gardening for a long time, but we've reached the point where a lot of people are now set up, they know what they need to do and they do it," Ms Witney said.

"There's nothing like that sense of achievement when you grow your own and you can enjoy it, but on the other side of the coin, it's just so disappointing when you think you are going to enjoy fresh fruit and find that you have fruit fly infestations.

"Our goal is to help people get that enjoyment back so we can all get the rewards that we used to – including the enjoyment of beautiful fresh fruit and vegetables."

The GSPFA Fruit Fly Fighters program offers home gardeners basic resources to tackle fruit fly.

"The Fruit Fly Fighters program offer gardeners free fruit fly traps and insect nets, an evaluation of their trees and free tree removal if they need it," Ms Witney said.

"You'll also get some free vegetable seeds for non-host plants like leafy greens, as well as access to technical experts and a community of like-minded people, and free check ins to see how you're going," Ms Beattie said.

Ms Witney said for home gardeners, her simplest and cheapest "fruit fly hack" is insect nets.

"I try very hard to convince people that it is well worth pruning trees back to a manageable height so they can get the nets on and get the enjoyment back – it's the simplest one step that any gardener can make, to get nets on, and get them on early," she said. "People understand the lifecycle of the Qfly much better now and that's important, because it gives you the knowledge about how to head off fruit fly at the pass, and what things you can implement at various stages.

"We are absolutely finding people in the community who have made the effort, taken the steps and are getting the rewards of harvesting beautiful fruit again. Sometimes it takes a year or two to get them on board completely, but once they know what to do they start talking to other people and the correct information starts going out, instead of all the myths."






