



Always update your phone's software. Check your software is updated (www.telstra.com.au/support/ mobiles-devices/3g-closure#lightbox-networkSettings) and network settings are correct, then set your network to automatic.

TIP: to make sure you have the latest software update, power cycle your phone by turning it off for a few minutes and then turning it back on. This forces the phone to refresh its network settings and will bring up the latest software update available

- 2 In a regional, rural or remote area? For optimal coverage, we recommend a Bluetick device. You can also consider getting coverage extension devices (www.telstra.com.au/coverage-networks/network-coverage-extension-devices) for home or on the road.





Australian Inland Botanic Gardens

In the far west of NSW is a unique and very special place, The Australian Inland Botanic Gardens, it is a wholly community owned and operated botanic garden that sits at Mourquong, NSW. The Gardens are funded by two councils in both Victoria and NSW. Much like the Sunraysia area itself, the garden is a melting pot of plants from many corners of the world.

It all came about way back in 1983 when a diverse group of individuals comprised of CSIRO scientists, horticulturists, botanists and local Sunraysia champions identified the need for a semi-arid land botanic garden. It wasn't until 1986 that the Sunraysia Oasis Botanical Gardens Inc group were officially formed. Two years later, in 1988, a 150 hectare site became available in the NSW local government area of Wentworth. This has now grown into the Australian Inland Botanic Gardens, a testament to what community spirit can achieve.

Officially opening to the public four years later in 1992 after many hours of tireless work from a small number of employees and more than 350 volunteers from both sides of the border. It now boasts four staff members and more than 100 volunteers that keep the 50 hectares of gardens and 100 hectares of native bush in check. No garden is complete without a place to have a relaxing meal or beverage, so the gardens have a coffee shop and other amenities on the site.



The feature product for this year's Mildura Field Days will be the Ascenco VF or very high flexion tyres. These differ from standard radial tractor tyres that run at set pressures in that these tyres are designed to handle higher loads at lower air pressures. They are typically used in machinery like tractors, harvesters, and loaders, where they help reduce soil compaction and improve fuel efficiency.

With a lower inflation pressure, without compromising load-bearing capacity, this further reduces the amount of pressure exhorted on the soil. Billabong Ranch

Billabong Ranch is based in Echuca, but this business is no stranger to the people of Mildura, they are here often with their camels and can be seen at events such as the Mildura Show and of course the Mildura Field Days, with this year being no exception. This year they have added to the camel rides with their animal nursery featuring goats, sheep and lambs, puppies, kittens, ducks, chooks, rabbits, guinea pigs, as well as a pony.

Rocky Acquisto, one of the owners and operators of the Billabong Ranch, is passionate about camels and the important part they play in the history of Australia. From the early Afghani cameleers that came to Broken Hill to open the outback to the part that Australia plays in having the only wild camels anywhere in the world wandering through the outback.

"The camel rides give people an opportunity to meet the camels and go on a short trek, it's always a great bucket list item and also a good way for families to get out and have a great day," Rocky said.

We have 20 camels and 150 horses, we produce 80 - 90% of our own hay on the farm. We are really trying to keep that Aussie pioneering heritage alive. Once it's gone the kids no longer have an opportunity to see or experience it."

The farm itself is situated on 500 acres on the Goulburn River and hosts more than 10,000 school kids on the property annually with the school camp programs they run. They are also open seven days a week as a fun park featuring archery, rock climbing, horse riding, pedal boats, outdoor ten pin bowling, indoor mini golf and beach volleyball just to name a few of the activities available.


